CLASSES FOR ENTRY

VEGETABLES

- 1 3 pods of beans (runner, French or Broad)
- 2 3 Beetroot (any sort) with tops
- 3 3 Turnips (with tops)
- 4 3 Carrots with tops (same variety)
- 5 3 Raddish with tops
- 6 3 Potatoes (same variety) - competition spuds - see category 32
- 7 2 Lettuce with Roots
- 8 1 Cabbage (over 1 1/2 Lbs) with roots
- 9 1 Cauliflower with roots
- 10 2 Leeks (any variety) Trimmed
- 11 2 Garlic without tops
- 12 6 Shallots or 3 Onions (red or white) without tops
- 13 1 Cucumber
- 14 3 sticks of Rhubarb
- 15 3 Apples (same variety)
- 16 Plate of soft fruit (min 6 berries) **can be mixed fruit**
- 17 3 courgettes
- 18 3 Chilli peppers or 3 sweet peppers (same variety)
- 19 8 cherry or 4 standard tomatoes (all same variety)
- 20 Plate of 2 vegetable not listed above

FLOWERS

All must be grown on the allotment

- 21 Vase of 6 stems - Perennial flowers
- 22 Vase of 6 annual flowers - any type
- 23 Vase of 10 stems- flowers -any type
- 24 Vase of 3 Dhalias or 3 Gladioli
- 25 vase of one cut Sunflower

EATS

All must be made from allotment produce

- 26 Jar of Jam or marmalade (from allotment produce)
- 27 Jar of Chutney or preserve from your allotment
- 28 Sweet tart or pie (shortcrust pastry)
- 29 Bread of any sort (flavoured with your produce)
- 30 Any other allotment made "eats"

DRINKS

All must be made from allotment produce

- 31 Any alcoholic or non alcoholic drink

OTHER PRODUCE / NON PRODUCE AWARDS

- 32 3 competition spuds (Ulster Prince as distributed)
- 33 Most unusual or ugliest shaped vegetable (anything)
- 34 Heaviest Vegetable (anything)
- 35 longest runner bean
