- 1 3 pods of beans (runner or Broad)
- 2 3 pods of beans (French)
- 3 6 pods of peas (any type)
- 4 3 Beetroot (any sort) with tops
- 5 3 Turnips (with tops)
- 6 3 Carrots with tops (same variety)
- 7 3 Parsnips with tops (same variety)
- 8 3 Radish with tops
- 9 3 Potatoes (same variety)
- 10 2 Lettuce with Roots
- 11 1 Cabbage (over 1 1/2 Lbs) with roots
- 12 1 Cauliflower with roots
- 13 1 head of Broccoli trimmed
- 14 2 Leeks (any variety) Trimmed
- 15 2 Garlic without tops
- 16 6 Shallots or 3 Onions (red or white) without tops
- 17 1 Cucumber
- 18 3 sticks of Rhubarb
- 19 3 Apples (same variety)
- 20 Plate of soft fruit (min 6 berries) **can be mixed fruit**
- 21 3 courgettes
- 22 3 Chilli peppers or 3 sweet peppers (same variety)
- 23 8 cherry tomatoes or 4 standard tomatoes (all same variety)
- 24 Plate of 2 vegetables not listed above

FLOWERS All must be grown on the allotment

- 25 Vase of 6 stems - Perennial flowers
- 26 Vase of 6 annual flowers - any type
- 27 Vase of 10 stems- flowers -any type
- 28 Vase of 3 Dhalias or 3 Gladioli
- 29 vase of one cut Sunflower

EATS All must be made from allotment produce

- 30 Jar of Jam or marmalade (from allotment produce)
- 31 Jar of Chutney or preserve from your allotment
- 32 Sweet tart or pie (shortcrust pastry)
- 33 Bread of any sort (flavoured with your produce)
- 34 Any other allotment made "eats"

DRINKS All must be made from allotment produce

- 35 Any alcoholic or non alcoholic drink

OTHER PRODUCE / NON PRODUCE AWARDS

- 36 Most unusual or ugliest shaped vegetable (anything)
- 37 Heaviest Vegetable (anything)
- 38 longest runner bean
- 39 Children - any painted stone or pebble
- 40 Children's drawing about the allotment (anything)
